- We will provide a leaflet for participants over the weekend describing and numbering each tree and giving its location.
- The Event will include a set of clues to be solved.
- Clues will be displayed at various trees (though not necessarily all, depending on how many entries we receive).
- The Church and Village Centre will be open on Saturday from 1000 – 1700. On Sunday the Church and Village Centre will be open for the Festival from 1300 – 1700.
- Light Refreshments will be available at the Village Centre from 1000 – 1700 on Saturday and from 1330 – 1700 on Sunday.
- Trees outside on the Trail will be lit up and able to be seen from 1500 – 2000 both days.
- Feel free to theme your tree to fit in with the title, “Christmas Carols”. If your theme fits a word in our list we will allocate that to you (first come basis in case of duplication). We can supply you with a theme if you ask. If trees are more general, we may or may not allocate a clue depending on numbers.
- A clue will be supplied to be displayed on or near the relevant tree, identified in the leaflet by numbers.
- Visitors will be asked to vote for the tree(s) they like best and there will be a small prize for the tree(s) with the most votes.
- **The organisers cannot be responsible for the safety of your tree and those who visit. By entering the Festival you accept that you will make sure your tree and any visitors are as safe as possible.**
